

GIUDITTA CORDERO-MOSS

Cordero-Moss er professor ved Institutt for privatrett ved Universitetet i Oslo, hvor hun blant annet underviser internasjonal privatrett, international commercial law og obligasjonsrett.

Hun har opprinnelig sin juridiske utdannelse fra Sapienza Universitet i Roma (1984) og doktorgrader fra Vitenskapsakademiet i Moskva (1995) og Det juridiske fakultet, Universitetet i Oslo (1999).

Før hun vendte tilbake til academia, praktiserte hun som advokat i nesten 15 år, blant annet som bedriftsadvokat i to multinasjonale selskaper - først i Italia og deretter i Norge.

Cordero-Moss publiserer og foreleser i Norge og internasjonalt. Hennes forskning og undervisning er viet problemstillinger slik de oppstår i praksis, og dette fører ofte til en tverrfaglig tilnærming. Blant hennes publikasjoner (291 vitenskapelige publikasjoner registrert i Cristin) er monografiene *Internasjonal privatrett* (2.utg., Universitetsforlaget 2021) og *International Commercial Contracts* (2. utg., Cambridge University Press 2023). Hun arbeider og publiserer også på italiensk, tysk, fransk or russisk.

Hun har blant annet i 2014 holdt forelesningsserien (Special Lectures) ved Haagakademiet for internasjonal rett, og er oppnevnt til å holde Hovedkurset (General Course) ved samme Akademi i 2027.

Hun har flere ganger vært invitert som gjesteforsker og -foreleser, blant annet ved New York University, Sciences Po (Paris), og Sorbonne Paris 1.

For tiden leder hun et tverrfaglig, internasjonalt forskningsprosjekt som bruker empiriske metoder utviklet i lingvistikk og psykologi for å kartlegge hvordan internasjonale kontrakter tolkes i voldgift. Prosjektet er et samarbeid mellom forskere fra de juridiske fakulteter ved Universiteter i Oslo, New York (New York University), Paris (Sciences Po), Sao Paolo, og Singapore (National University of Singapore), samt fra Psykologisk Institutt ved UiO, Instituttet for psykologi ved Columbia University, og instituttene for lingvistikk ved universitetene i Aston (Storbritannia) og Pavia (Italia).

Hun har flere verv i Norge, blant annet har hun siden 2014 vært nestleder i Finanstilsynets styre og siden 2015 medlem i Tariffnemnda. På oppdrag fra Justisdepartementet skrev hun i 2018 utredningen om en ny lov om lovvalg på det formuerettslige område. I perioden 2011-2020 har hun vært redaktør i Norges største juridiske tidsskrift, Universitetsforlagets *Lov og Rett*, og i perioden 2012-2015 Instituttleder for Institutt for privatrett, Universitetet i Oslo (nestleder 08-11).

Hun har flere verv internasjonalt, blant annet har hun siden 2022 vært president i Det internasjonale akademi for komparativ rett, og siden 2019 vært medlem i kuratoriet ved Haagakademiet for internasjonal rett. Hun var medlem av den administrative domstolen til den Europeiske bank for gjenoppbygging og utvikling (EBRD) fra 2007 til 2020, de to siste årene som domstolens president. I perioden 2018-2024 har hun vært medlem i Det internasjonale handelskammerets domstol.
